

Increasing Mediation for Landlords & Tenants

Thanks to the support of the Hawaii Justice Foundation and Aloha United Way, the MCP staff and mediators have continued to grow the Early Access Mediation Program for Landlords and Tenants. In addition to reaching out to various members of the community, on January 19th, a five-hour training was conducted for thirty mediators. Topics included landlord-tenant law; the responsibilities of and the issues faced by landlords and tenants; challenges in landlord-tenant mediations; agreement writing; and working with the newly housed homeless. MCP is grateful to attorneys David Chee, Dan O'Meara and Richard Yanagi for sharing their expertise and conducting portions of the training. MCP is also grateful to the Collaborative Leader Network for the use of its training room and to Linda Colburn for hosting the event. Mediation Badge for Girl Scouts

MCP was pleased to once again collaborate with the Girl Scouts and the Judicial History Center to train sixty-nine Girl Scouts ages 9 to 13 years old in conflict resolution, negotiation and mediation skills. The young scouts learned how to find common ground, actively listen, work through a compromise and more. They were also provided with the opportunity to conduct a mock trial as well as a mock mediation. The three-hours with the Juniors (grades 3—5) and the Cadettes (grades 6–8) were action-packed, high energy sessions full of enthusiasm and giggles. By the end of the sessions, each Scout earned their Mediation Badge. In the exit surveys completed by the Scouts, they shared that the lessons and skills they learned were valuable and they would be incorporating the skills into their lives at home and at school. Perhaps MCP should consider creating a similar program for adults.....
