WORKSHOPS & TRAININGS

To support the mediators who so generously volunteer their services throughout the year and to ensure that quality services are provided to every client, MCP's staff regularly coordinates and conducts workshops and trainings. Over the past three months, a three-hour Child Support Guidelines Workshop involving 21 mediators, a four-hour Parenting Plan Workshop involving 18 mediators, a one-hour Mediator Brown Bag Gathering on "Mediation Challenges" involving 6 mediators, and a four-hour Landlord-Tenant Mediation Workshop involving 18 mediators, were conducted.

MCP is grateful to Jessi Hall and Owen Tamamoto for conducting the Child Support Guidelines Workshop and to Charlene Anaya and Rosemary McShane for conducting the Parenting Plan Workshop. Both workshops received top reviews and the mediators agreed that they learned a lot of new skills and ideas to apply in the domestic cases that they mediate.



MEDIATION TRAINING FOR KEIKI TO KUPUNA

In addition to providing training and workshops for the mediators, MCP staff regularly conducts a variety of trainings in mediation, conflict resolution, facilitation, managing difficult conversations and more, for individuals and businesses in Hawaii's communities. Over the past three months, MCP conducted a 24-hour Basic Mediation Training for 24 participants, an 8-hour Elder Mediation Training for 24 mediators with Ku`ikahi and West Hawaii Mediation Centers, an 8 - hour Mediation Skills for Managers Training for 14 participants, a 1-hour Effective Facilitation Webinar for 30 healthcare providers, and a 3.5-hour Mediation Workshop for 23 Girl Scouts. Through these trainings and workshops, the participants learn mediation and conflict resolution skills to prevent and resolve conflicts in their workplaces, schools and communities.
